

Summer Internship Small Acreage Outreach Project

Job Description:

University of Wyoming Cooperative Extension Service is offering two summer internships working in Southeast Wyoming based out of **Laramie**. This position will be one of two interns working as a team to coordinate small acreage events on land management issues, create educational tools and provide educational resources to landowners. The pair will work under the direction of the Small Acreage Issue Team, a collaborative effort of conservation professionals. During this internship you will gain familiarity with several natural resource agencies and personnel. Responsibilities include: providing landowners with resources that are available to help them with land management practices, organizing workshops, attending events to promote project activities, creating brochures and other educational tools, writing press releases and reports on activities, and learning about sustainable land management practices. Applicants should be able to work with limited supervision and be comfortable in rural areas.
